Purpose and Summary	This Regulation is framed to ensure protection of ancient historical monuments within Nepal following the powers conferred by the section 21 of the Ancient Monuments Protection Act, 1956. The Regulation lays down provisions relating to formation, functions, duties and powers of the technical and cooperation committee dedicated to the protection of the ancient monuments and also specifies the standards of construction works and mandatory permissions. The Regulation is organized in four chapters.																																								
Application	All public works must comply with this Regulation and its associated Act, in particular environmental and social assessment studies during project preparation must consider any ancient monuments in the project area. All construction works which may affect an ancient monument must be planned and executed in compliance with the Regulation.

Purpose and Summary	This Regulation is made by the Ministry of Water Resources for all public and private companies seeking permission for the generation, distribution and utilization of electricity from national waterpower resources. It is published in two separate notifications of the Nepal Gazette. Notification #2 is divided into eight chapters and lists the regulations regarding permission to conduct the survey, rules to be abided by the distributors and consumers, safety measures of electrical equipment/works, inspection and enquiry, etc. Notification #4 is divided into seven chapters and lists the regulations regarding constitution of consumers' society, water resources utilization, enquiry related to the disputes on water resource utilization, electricity service charge, acquisition of house and land and compensation of damages. Contents of each chapter are given below.

Purpose and Summary	This regulation was made by the Nepal Electricity Authority Board in compliance with Nepal Electricity Authority Act, July/August 1996, article 35 to undertake all kinds of works by the Nepal Electricity Authority and all its offices and projects. The regulation is sub-divided into six sections, of which the fifth one is related with procurement, construction, transport, consultancy and other services. The contents of this section are given below. At the end of this chapter the rights of the related authorities are given in a form of an appendix. The remaining chapters deal mainly with internal financial matters that are more related with the staff of the Nepal Electricity Authority itself.

Purpose and Summary	The Regulation is framed under the Environment Protection Act, 2054 and provides procedures and criteria for carrying out Initial Environmental Examination (IEE), Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Environmental Monitoring. In most of the medium or major projects, environmental studies have been made mandatory.																																																	
Application	This Regulation identifies the criteria for determining what type of environmental assessment is required (none, IEE or full EIA), the type of impacts to be addressed in the environmental assessment, the reporting requirements and the approval process. All public works projects must comply with the provisions in the Act and no project may proceed without the environmental approvals specified in the Regulation.

Purpose and Summary	This Regulation is describes the various rules related to identification, implementation, operation and maintenance of local level water supply schemes through a participatory approach using water user's committees. The Regulation is intended to ensure the sustainability of water supply schemes at the local level. The Regulation deals with the formation of water user's committees, resolution of disputes on water resources, guidelines for protection and maintenance of constructed schemes, and establishing the water tariff.

Purpose and Summary	This is the most important document governing financial procedures for public works projects. The Regulation is organized in 18 chapters, 204 sections and 23 schedules. The Regulation repeals Governmental Amounts (Management) Rules, 2016 (1959), Ration Contract Management Rules, 2018, (1961), Governmental Amounts Recovery and Settlement Regulation, 2027 (1970), Daily and Travelling Allowance Regulation, 2030 (1973), Advance Settlement Regulation, (1975), Governmental Income and Expenditure Operation (Procedure) Regulation, 2038 (1981), Rules relating to Financial Administration, 2042 (1985) and Deposit Regulation, 2045 (1988). Hence, it is the most important regulation governing most public works financial procedures.																																																													
Application	The Financial Administration Regulation contains the basic requirements for the government's financial administration including all requirements which must be met in appraisal, approval, budgeting and implementation of a project. It provides procedures for approval of engineering designs, cost estimates and procedures for the procurement of works, good and consultant services. The Public Works Directives elaborate upon these requirements by providing a set of organizational and procedural directives and bidding documents to be used in implementing public works projects.
