For Drone Survey and Topographical Mapping Services
Date of Publication: 5th May 2026

Department of Roads (DoR), Road Improvement and Development Project Directorate, invites applications from qualified individual experts/a consulting firm for enlistment in the standing list to provide drone-based survey and mapping services for the current fiscal year. The engagement will be on a need basis for a specified number of input days during the contract period.

Scope of Services (Terms of Reference – TOR):

- Conduct topographical surveys in Mahakali River, Kanchanpur for Hydrological Modeling using drone technology (Appropriate Drone should be available with expert/firm; appropriate costing shall be considered during proposal phase)
- Perform benchmarking and referencing
- Establish Ground Control Points (GCPs)
- Process the Survey Data and make a Digital Elevation Model (DEM)
- Carry out data validation and accuracy verification of river geometry, river profile, cross-sections.
- Provide additional technical suggestions and improvements to the TOR in coordination with the office

As per the Public Procurement Act, 2007, Clause 6(ka), eligible and interested experts are requested to submit their application for enlistment in the standing list along with the following documents via email to: ridp.dor.gov.np@gmail.com

Requirements for Enlistment:

1. PAN / VAT registration document (mandatory prior to payment if selected)
2. Tax clearance certificate or extension for FY 2081/82 or later (not required for newly registered applicants)
3. Curriculum Vitae (CV) including academic qualifications and relevant experience

Minimum Qualification and Experience:

1. Minimum 3 years of relevant experience in drone surveying / geomatics / mapping
2. Masters' degree in Geomatics Engineering / Survey Engineering / Civil Engineering or equivalent.

Deadline for Submission:

Within 8th May 2026.

The Directorate will prepare the standing list based on submitted qualifications and experience. Selection and engagement will be carried out as per the Public Procurement Act, 2007 and Public Procurement Regulations, 2008.
