1. *The Government of Nepal [GoN] Road Division Surkhet has allocated funds or received a grant from GoN towards the cost of Desing and Build of Bridge over Dahi khola Along Surkht- Jumla Road (Chainage 132+000 km) , Dailekh and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for RDSKT/33701132-4/083/84-19"Re". Bidding is open to all eligible as per Section V of bidding document.*
2. *Road Division Surkhet, Subbakuna invites sealed bids or electronic bids from eligible bidders for the construction of Desing and Build of Bridge over Dahi Khola Along Surkht- Jumla Road (Chainage 132+000 km) , Dailekh, through Design and Build Contract under National Competitive Bidding (NCB) – Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures.*
Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of the best 3 years within the last 10 years: **NRs. 67 million.**
 - Minimum Work experience of similar size and nature: **18m and 67 million.**
3. *Under the Single Stage: Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate sealed envelopes, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, both in turn enclosed in one sealed envelope as per the provision of ITB 22 of the Bidding Document.*

- of 90 days from the bid submission deadline and must be accompanied by a bid security, amounting to a minimum of NRs.3.25 million which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
13. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.

Section III: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

This Section contains all the criteria that the Employer shall use to evaluate bids and qualify Bidders by post-qualification exercise. GoN/DP requires bidders to be qualified by meeting predefined, precise minimum requirements. The method sets pass-fail criteria, which, if not met by the bidder, results in disqualification. No other methods, criteria and factors, except those specified in the Bidding Documents, shall be used. The Bidder shall provide all the information requested in the forms included in Section IV (Bidding Forms).

1. Evaluation

Note:

1.1 Adequacy of Technical Proposal

Evaluation of the Bidder's Technical Proposal will include an assessment of the Bidder's technical capacity, to mobilize key equipment and personnel for the contract consistent with its proposal regarding work methods, scheduling, and material sourcing in sufficient detail and fully in accordance with the requirements stipulated in Section VI (Employer's Requirements).

Non-compliance with equipment and personnel requirements described in Section VI (Employer's Requirements) shall not be grounds for bid rejection and such non-compliance will be subject to clarification.

1.2 Multiple Contracts

Multiple Contracts, if permitted under ITB 36.4, will be evaluated as follows:

Award Criteria for Multiple Contracts [ITB 36.4]:

Bidders have the option to Bid for any one or more Contracts. Bids will be evaluated taking into account discounts offered, if any, for combined contracts. The contract(s) will be awarded to the Bidder or Bidders offering the lowest evaluated cost to the Employer for combined contracts of bids closest to the average bid price, subject to the selected Bidder(s) meeting the required qualification criteria for combination of multiple contracts as the case may be.

Qualification Criteria for Multiple Contracts:

The criteria for qualification shall be the sum of the minimum requirements for respective individual contracts as specified under items 2.3.2, 2.3.3, 2.3.4 and 2.4.2 b.

With respect to the **Contracts of Similar Size and Nature** under item 2.4.2(a) of Section III, the evaluation shall be done as below:

N is the minimum number of contracts required as per Specific Construction Experience (2.4.2(a)).



V is the minimum value of a single contract as per Note (2), or (3) of 2.4.2 Specific Construction Experience.

- i. Minimum requirements for combined contract(s) shall be the aggregate requirements for each contract for which the bidder has submitted bids as follows, and N_1, N_2, N_3 , etc. shall be different contracts:

1.2 Quantifiable Nonconformities, Errors and Omissions

The evaluation shall be based on the evaluated cost of fulfilling all of the Contract obligations as laid down under this Bidding Document. Accordingly, the Employer shall proceed with a Bid price adjustment whenever there are quantifiable nonconformities, errors and Omissions item(s) or component(s) in a Bid, to correct the effect of those in order to be able to compare all Bids on an equal basis, i.e., on the basis of the same set of Contract obligations.
