1. **The Government of Nepal [GoN] has allocated funds** from [GoN] towards the cost of **Periodic Maintenance works of Kalche - Botechaur Road, Surkhet District, NH09-035** and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract **for Contract ID No: RDSKT/33731011-3/083/84-21**. Bidding is open to all eligible as per Section V of bidding document.
2. **Road Division Surkhet** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of **Periodic Maintenance works of Kalche - Botechaur Road, Surkhet District, NH09-035** under National Competitive Bidding procedures— Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures.

Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of the best 3 years within the last 10 years: **161.6 million**
- Minimum Work experience of similar size and nature:
 - One partner must have Participated as Prime contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least One (1) road construction work within the last ten (10) years, with a value of at least NRs 64.632 Million that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works. The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described road construction works.
 - Each partner must have Participated as Prime contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least One (1) road construction work within the last ten (10) years, with a value of at least NRs 10.772 Million that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works. The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described road construction works.
- 3. Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate sealed envelopes, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, both in turn enclosed in one sealed envelope as per the provision of ITB 21 of the Bidding Document.

Bids must be valid for a period of **90 days** from the bid submission deadline and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy, amounting to a minimum of **NRs 27,00,000**, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid
9. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.



Section III: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

This Section contains all the criteria that the Employer shall use to evaluate bids and qualify Bidders by post-qualification exercise. GoN/DP requires bidders to be qualified by meeting predefined, precise minimum requirements. The method sets pass-fail criteria, which, if not met by the bidder, results in disqualification. In accordance with ITB 32 and ITB 35, no other methods, criteria and factors shall be used. The Bidder shall provide all the information requested in the forms included in Section IV (Bidding Forms).

1.1 Adequacy of Technical Proposal

Evaluation of the Bidder's Technical Proposal will include an assessment of the Bidder's technical capacity, to mobilize key equipment and personnel for the contract consistent with its proposal regarding work methods, scheduling, and material sourcing in sufficient detail and fully in accordance with the requirements stipulated in Section VI (Works Requirements).

Non-compliance with equipment and personnel requirements described in Section VI (Works Requirements) shall not be grounds for bid rejection and such non-compliance will be subject to clarification and rectification prior to contract award.

1.2 Multiple Contracts

Multiple Contracts, if permitted under ITB 35.4, will be evaluated as follows:

Award Criteria for Multiple Contracts [ITB 35.4]:

Bidders have the option to Bid for any one or more Contracts. Bids will be evaluated taking into account discounts offered, if any, for combined contracts. The contract(s) will be awarded to the Bidder or Bidders offering the lowest evaluated cost to the Employer for combined contracts, subject to the selected Bidder(s) meeting the required qualification criteria for combination of multiple contracts as the case may be.

Qualification Criteria for Multiple Contracts:

The criteria for qualification shall be the sum of the minimum requirements for respective



individual contracts as specified under items 2.3.2, 2.3.3, 2.3.4 and 2.4.2 b.

Under this case, the Contract shall be awarded based on Least Cost Combination to the Employer.
